Introduction

These instructions describe the installation procedure to update ResSim. It is assumed that the RFC will be updated to FEWS 2023.02 build 135114, patched from 130690 and currently has ResSim-3.1.RC4_27665. If you have any questions during the installation, please contact the CHPS Support Group (part of the Field Support and Infrastructure team in the Office of Central Processing). The install instructions will guide you through the following steps:

- 1. Extract the ResSim package
- 2. Standalone installation and testing
- 3. OC installation and testing on a Dev/Test system
- 4. FSS installation and testing on a Dev/Test system
- 5. FSS installation and testing on an Operational system
- 6. Roll out update to all Operator Client

Note: the instructions for installing on a Dev/Test and Operational system are essentially the same except for the machines you are installing on.

Commands that have to be entered will be displayed in a fixed width font like this:

\$ ls -1 /awips/chps share/

Installation Instructions Using the ressim_install.sh Script

- 1. Extract the ResSim-3.3.1.145 package
 - 1.1. Log in to an LX workstation as user *fews*. Navigate to the CHPS- 24.1.1 directory.
 - \$ cd /awips/chps_share/install/CHPS-24.1.1/installScripts/
 - 1.2. Run the install script to extract the package.
 - \$./ressim install.sh
 - 1.3. Once complete, you may move onto standalone installation and testing.
- 2. Standalone Installation and Testing
 - 2.1. Log in to an LX workstation as user fews.
 - 2.2. Create an up to date Standalone client for testing.

- 2.3. Run the install script to make a link to point to the downloaded software inside the SA's Models directory.
 - \$ cd /awips/chps share/install/CHPS-24.1.1/installScripts/
 - \$./ressim install.sh sa </path/to/your/test/sa/Models/hec/ressim>
- 2.4. Verify the SA global properties file points RESSIM_BIN_DIR to the ResSim *bin* and RESSIM_APP_DIR to the ResSim *application* in the step above.
- 2.5. Test to make sure all workflows complete as expected. Raise any issues with the Support Group through Redmine. You may move onto the next step once satisfied with Standalone testing.
- 3. Operator Client Installation and Testing for Dev/Test purposes

NOTE: These instructions will walk you through installation and testing on both a Dev/Test system. Perform these actions on your Dev/Test system first.

- 3.1. Log in to an LX workstation as user fews.
- 3.2. Run the install script to make a link to point to the downloaded ResSim software under the OC's Models directory.

```
$ cd /awips/chps_share/install/CHPS-24.1.1/installScripts/
```

- \$./ressim_install.sh dev oc </path/to/your/test/oc/Models/hec/ressim>
- 3.3. Test to make sure all workflows complete as expected. Raise any issues with the Support Group through Redmine.
- 4. FEWS Shell Installation and Testing for Dev/Test purposes (DevTest-chps9)

NOTE: These instructions will walk you through installation and testing on a Dev/Test. Perform these actions on your Dev/Test system first.

- 4.1. Log in to chps9 as user fews.
- 4.2. Check the Admin Interface if any tasks are running at the FSSs. If no tasks are running, run the install script with the following command.

```
$ cd /awips/chps_share/install/CHPS-24.1.1/installScripts/
$ ./ressim install.sh fss
```

- 4.3. Test to make sure all workflows complete as expected. Raise any issues with the Support Group through Redmine.
- 5. FEWS Shell Installation and Testing for you Operational systems (OpsBackup-chps6 / OpsPrimary-chps3)

NOTE: These instructions will walk you through installation and testing on an Operational System. **These** actions will affect your Primary and Secondary (backup) Operational systems.

- 5.1. Log in to chps6 as user fews.
- 5.2. Check the Admin Interface if any tasks are running at the FSSs. If no tasks are running, run the install script with the following command.

```
$ cd /awips/chps_share/install/CHPS-24.1.1/installScripts/
$ ./ressim install.sh fss
```

5.3. Test to make sure all workflows complete as expected. Raise any issues with the Support Group through Redmine.

- 5.4. Repeat steps 5.1 through 5.3, this time logging into your **Primary Operational system's FSS** machine (usually chps3).
- 6. Roll out update to all Operator Client

Once the tests with the Operator Client are satisfying, the ResSim binaries can be rolled out to all OCs.

NOTE: These instructions will walk you through installation on your Operational systems. **These actions** will affect your Primary and Secondary (backup) Operational systems.

- 6.1. Log in to an LX workstation as user fews.
- 6.2. Run the install script to make a link to point to the downloaded ResSim software under the OC's Models directory.

```
$ cd /awips/chps_share/install/CHPS-24.1.1/installScripts/
$ ./ressim install.sh oc
```

6.3. Test to make sure all workflows complete as expected. Raise any issues with the Support Group through Redmine.

Rolling Back an ResSim Release

In the case where the ResSim release needs to be rolled back to a previous version:

Log in to an LX workstation as user fews.

- 1. For an SA, restore links and references in your SA global properties to the previous release (i.e. bin 3.1.RC4 27665). Run the script with the following command

 - \$./ressim_install.sh rollback sa
- 2. For an OC, Run the script with the following command
 - \$ cd /awips/chps share/install/CHPS-24.1.1/installScripts/
 - \$./ressim install.sh rollback oc
- 3. For your FSS. Run the script with the following command
 - \$ cd /awips/chps share/install/CHPS-24.1.1/installScripts/
 - $\ ./ressim_install.sh\ rollback\ fss$
